#### A Story of Renewed Faith and Joy

At fourteen, I became a mother, and by age twenty, I dropped out of school, falling into the clutches of cocaine addiction, and adding two more children to my life. Over the next four years, two more children arrived, and I faced my father's loss and a tumultuous divorce. Loneliness and despair led me to believe no one would accept a single mother of five. Seeking solace in destructive relationships, I spiraled into meth addiction. As my addiction tore my family apart, I realized I needed help. Frustration and anger ensued when my family couldn't provide a solution, leading to my expulsion.

We became homeless, moving from one hotel to another. I continued battling addiction, sometimes in the presence of my children. Eventually, a 72-hour hold in a mental health facility seemed my only way out. The first rehab didn't succeed, but my aunt intervened, bringing me to the Dream Center. Here, God has been restoring my sanity, faith, trust, and reshaping me into a compassionate and kind person.

Now, I'm reuniting with my family, witnessing my mom's joy, and finding safety, healing, and hope. With God as my focus, my life is falling into place, and I'm ready to help others.

### A Life Transformed By God's Grace

My name is Tiffany, and today I'm 33 years old. I battled addiction for nearly 20 years, losing everything in the process, including my husband and children. In April 2020, I hit rock bottom, faced with a choice: seek help or risk losing my life. My husband, already in recovery, urged me to join New Beginnings, hoping to salvage our marriage. To succeed, God had to become the center of my life and our relationship.

Recovery was incredibly challenging; I had to transform my entire mindset and fully surrender to the Lord. Through this journey, my family reunited, my marriage was restored, and we welcomed new additions.

I'm deeply thankful to God for lifting me out of the darkness. These past three years, I've lived clean and addiction-free—all glory to God!
